## WHAT IS IT?

PreKindergarten is an opportunity for children to learn through play. The Pre-Kindergarten program focuses on providing meaningful learning experiences that promote healthy development of the whole child—emotional, social, physical, intellectual and spiritual. It is a busy place filled with laughter and excitement as children interact with each other.

## Who Is It For?

This program is for children 3 and 4 years old. Preference for the program is given to children who may require additional supports to become successful learners.

Application forms are available at each school. Acceptance into the Prek program is determined through a selection committee. All applicants will be contacted regarding their acceptance.



## Benefits:

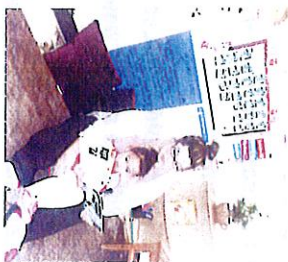

## When Is It?

Children will attend PreKindergarten for 3 hours per day Monday through Thursday.

Family Engagements are held once per month to provide family education opportunities.

Open communication between home and school is valued.
